From <u>Dublin</u>, head south to <u>Cork</u> via Tipperary. See the Bantry Bay and <u>Beara Peninsula</u> areas. Then head into Kerry with stops in <u>Kenmare</u> and <u>Dingle</u>. Visit the Cliffs of Moher in <u>Clare</u> before visiting <u>Connemara</u> in <u>Galway</u>.

Blarney Stone & Rock Of Cashel



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin**, at 8.10am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Take a self-guided tour of the Rock of Cashel (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It's an epic way to begin our Irish odyssey.

Then it's time to kiss the **Blarney Stone** (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle.**

We'll trace the valley of the River Lee, crossing stone bridges and passing through picturesque countryside.

Bantry House & Boat Trip



GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to GLENGARRIFF, CORK

Your morning will be spent exploring the many delights of **Bantry Bay**.

Visit stately **Bantry House**, a grand Irish home built in the 18th century (Fee Included). Please note, Bantry House opens from April to October.

Alternatively, learn about the epic last stand of a Gaelic chieftain at 16th centiury **Carriganass Castle**.

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote **Beara Peninsula**.

Of the four peninsulas in Ireland's southwest, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors. It has the feeling of true wilderness.

Look out for seals on a scenic boat trip to **Garnish Island**. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extra). Garnish Island opens from April to October. Departures in March can instead choose a guided harbour tour by boat (Optional Extra).

Horse Carriage Ride In Killarney



GLENGARRIFF, CORK to DINGLE, KERRY

Start the day with a spin over either the Caha or Healy Pass, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

Take a horse-drawn carriage ride around Killarney National Park (Optional Extra).

Your visit to Killarney National Park may also include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House and Gardens
- A short walk to scenic Torc Waterfall
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive the extraordinary deeds of its one time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. This morning, soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following relaxed activities.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C):

- A. Take a **boat trip** around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **B.** Savour a guided **craft tour** of the Dingle Crystal studio.
- **C.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

Experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Whatever you do in **Dingle**, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.

Cliffs Of Moher & Farm Tour



DINGLE, KERRY to LAHINCH, CLARE

After another hearty Irish breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to **Dingle**.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** and **guided farm tour** (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may happen on Day 7.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in **Clare** (Fee Included).

Cruise along the west Clare coastline with uninterrupted ocean vistas and the **Aran Islands** lying only 8km (5 miles) offshore.

Connemara Castle Tour



LAHINCH, CLARE to CLIFDEN, GALWAY

Hold onto your hat! It's the world famous **Cliffs of Moher** (Fee Included). These majestic 700ft high sea cliffs hold the power to dazzle.

Next is the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque **Dunguaire Castle** in the village of Kinvara, on Galway Bay.

We're aiming for **Galway** next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Take a guided tour of 16th century **Aughnanure Castle**, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

Revel in the savage beauty of **Connemara**, famed for its traditional Irish culture, misty mountains, wild moorlands and dark lakes.

CLIFDEN, GALWAY to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — slán in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Northern Ireland's highlights.

What's the classic postcard image of Ireland? We think you'll find it amid the savage beauty of **Connemara**.

There's a quick photo stop at **Kylemore Abbey** – one of Ireland's most scenic historic buildings.

Take a **guided farm tour** and watch a **sheepdog demo** at Tom Nee's farm (Fee Included). The setting above **Killary Harbour** could not be more scenic. Please note, this activity occurs on Day 5 for some departures.

Explore the historic ruins of 15th century **Ross Errilly Friary** or the picturesque village of Cong, filming location for John Wayne's The Quiet Man.

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new friends.
