Heading south from **Dublin**, you'll explore Tipperary en route to the charming coastline of **Cork**. Stay two nights in **Waterford**, Ireland's oldest city, then wander the cobbled streets of **Kilkenny**, returning to Dublin via **the Wicklow Mountains** and Glendalough.



This tour travels around Ireland in a counter clockwise direction.





Explore historic cities, like **Kilkenny** and **Waterford**; both with elegant medieval buildings.



Soak up **stunning scenery** in the **Wicklow Mountains National Park**, Ireland's largest upland wilderness area.



Encounter jaw-dropping landscapes at **Glendalough**, a 6th century monastic site in a glaciated valley.



Experience **quaint villages**, such as **Cobh**, 'one of Europe's most beautiful small towns' (Condé Nast Traveler).



Take an **Irish whiskey tasting tour** at the historic Jameson Distillery near Cork.



Tour secluded coves and ancient relics along the criminally underrated **Copper Coast**.



Kiss the **Blarney Stone** and wander through the magical **Blarney Castle & Gardens**.



Enjoy a guided tour of the oldest intact operational lighthouse in the world at **Hook Head**.



Follow in the footsteps of **Viking raiders** and **Norman knights**, who invaded and settled Ireland's southeast.

Cahir Castle & Blarney Stone



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to KINSALE, CORK

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, Dublin, at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 7.50am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

We'll stop at monumental Cahir Castle (Fee Included) for a guided tour. Gaze in awe at the imposing walls, keep and tower of one of Ireland's largest medieval fortresses. It's a fitting way to begin our southern Irish odyssey.

Now it's time to kiss the world famous **Blarney Stone** or explore the lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle** (Fee Included).

Seafood fans rejoice! The gorgeous harbour town of **Kinsale** boasts vibrant restaurants, atmospheric pubs and abundant craft shops.







Enjoy the calmness of being by the sea at the Garryvoe Hotel where coastal charm meets luxury.

Cobh & Irish Whiskey Tour



KINSALE, CORK to BALLYCOTTON, CORK

This morning, choose between free time exploring the colourful streets of **Kinsale** or a scenic coastal drive to the Old Head of Kinsale.

We'll drop into **Cobh** next. This maritime town — pronounced *cove* — lies on an island in Cork Harbour. Visit the Queenstown Experience to learn about Irish emigration and Cobh's role in the final voyage of the Titanic (Optional Extra).

Then it's **Kindred Spirits**, a poignant sculpture that commemorates Native American aid for 19th century Irish famine victims.

Spirits of a different kind are on the menu at the **Jameson Distillery** in **Midleton** (Fee Included). Enjoy a guided tour at the home of Irish whiskey — including an all-important whiskey tasting!

Comeragh Mountains & Copper Coast



BALLYCOTTON, CORK to WATERFORD CITY

We'll start today with a scenic drive through the **Comeragh Mountains**, including a short walk to **Mahon Falls**.

Discover secret coves and geological wonders on the **Copper Coast**. It's one of Ireland's least visited but most rewarding coastal routes.

Arrive this evening in **Waterford**, for the first of two nights exploring Ireland's oldest city.

Orient yourself with the historic centre of Waterford on a guided walking tour. The walking tour can be included as part of the Waterford Freedom Pass (Optional Extra).

Lighthouse Tour & Waterford City



WATERFORD to HOOK PENINSULA, WEXFORD (and return)

The morning, walk in awe around the ruins and walled garden at 13th century **Tintern Abbey** (Fee Included).

Take a guided tour of **Hook Lighthouse** (Fee Included). This is the world's oldest continually-operating lighthouse; a beacon was first lit here 850 years ago.

This afternoon is yours to design in Waterford city.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C)

- A. Tour the House of Waterford Crystal, the world's largest Waterford Crystal collection (Optional Extra).
- B. Watch Norsemen come to life at the King of the Vikings VR Experience (Optional Extra).
- C. Gain access to four amazing attractions with the Waterford Freedom Pass (Optional Extra). Includes Medieval Museum, Bishop's Palace Museum, the Irish Silver Museum and the Museum of Time.





PEMBROKE HOTEL KILKENNY



Get comfortable at the Pembroke in Kilkenny after an exciting day of touring Ireland's southeast.

WATERFORD to KILKENNY

In the historic town of **New Ross**, step aboard an atmospheric replica 1840s emigrant vessel - the **Dunbrody Famine Ship** (Fee Included).

This afternoon, explore Kilkenny's cobbled streets with ample free time to wander.

- A. Look out for the ghost of Strongbow on a self-guided tour of Kilkenny Castle (Optional Extra)

- **C.** Discover Ireland's medieval capital on foot, mixing facts and fun, on a **Shenanigans Walking Tour** (Optional Extra)

KILKENNY to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — slán in Irish — there's still time for you to catch some of southern Ireland's most amazing sights.

Travel back to the Bronze Age at **Rathgall**, one of Ireland's largest and most ancient ringforts.

Next, drop into the hillside village of **Hollywood**. Enjoy a **sheepdog** demo at a nearby Irish sheep farm (Fee Included).

You'll feel much further than 60 minutes from Dublin in the Wicklow Mountains National Park, part of Ireland's largest upland wilderness.

Our final stop is **Glendalough**. This 6th century monastic city is located in a steep mountain valley. It's a fitting end to our southern Ireland odyssey!

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in Dublin between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new friends.
