Historic Tour of Belfast & Castle Stay

DAY 1 - GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, Dublin, at 8.10am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Revel at the medieval tower, monastic ruins and Celtic high crosses of [Monasterboice](#).

Cross the border into [Northern Ireland](#) (remember, UK £ sterling required).

We'll roll into [Belfast](#), the vibrant capital of Northern Ireland.

Choose one of these activity options in Belfast:

- Take a highly-recommended Black Cab Tour of Belfast with a local driver guide, visiting political murals and learning the origins and legacy of the Troubles era (Tour Option - £15 per person)
- Grab an audio guide and enjoy a self-guided visit of the Titanic Centre, the world's largest Titanic visitor experience (Tour Option - £21.50 per person)
- Enjoy free time to explore Belfast's shopping and cultural attractions.

Your accommodation tonight is the 17th century castle tower and hotel at [Ballygally](#), situated directly on the beautiful Antrim coast.

The average driving time today is 3 hours 30 minutes.

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Northern Ireland Tour & Giant's Causeway

DAY 2 - BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM to DERRY/LONDONDERRY

Cameras at the ready! You're about to experience one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives; Antrim's [Causeway Coastal Route](#).

40,000 hexagonal basalt columns make up the [Giant's Causeway](#), Northern Ireland's UNESCO World Heritage Site. Choose to walk in the footsteps of mythical giant Finn McCool on a steep 1km (1.6 mile) descent/ascent. Or simply follow the accessible path to a viewing point.

[Game of Thrones](#) fan alert! Look out for Theon Greyjoy stepping ashore at tiny Ballintoy harbour.

Anyone for a wee dram? Visit Bushmills, the oldest licensed whiskey distillery in the world, for a tasting (Tour Option - £10 per person).

We'll grab a photo stop at clifftop [Dunluce Castle](#) before passing through historic gates to enter the city of Derry/Londonderry.

Your accommodation and dining tonight is at either the [Shipquay Hotel](#) or the [Roe Park Hotel](#).

The average driving time today is 3 hours.

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Donegal, Sligo & Historic Guided Tour of Derry

DAY 3 - BALLINA, MAYO to DERRY/LONDONDERRY

Start the day with a guided historical walking tour along the walls of Ireland's only fortified city, [Derry/Londonderry](#) (Tour Option - £6 per person).

Cross the border into the Republic of Ireland and the euro currency zone (€).

Panoramic 360° vistas await you at the beautifully preserved Celtic stone ringfort at Grianán of Aileach.

Stop into [Donegal](#) town, with the option for a guided tour of 15th century [Donegal Castle](#).

Honour Irish Nobel Laureate, W.B. Yeats, at his final resting place in [Sligo](#).

Accommodation tonight is at the stunning [Mount Falcon Estate](#). Enjoy delicious food, a romantic woodland setting and a wealth of history.

The average driving time today is 3 hours 30 minutes.

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Mayo, Connemara & Sheepdog Demo

DAY 4 - BALLINA, MAYO to CLIFDEN, GALWAY

Discover Ireland's rich rural heritage at the Museum of Country Life's modern exhibition space and Victorian landscaped gardens.

Pit stop in [Westport](#), with its vibrantly painted streets and grand setting on Clew Bay.

Lose a sin with every step on the holy mountain of Croagh Patrick. Nearby lies the ruined 16th century Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine Memorial.

Take a deep breath... Next is the [Doolough Valley](#), one of Ireland's most scenic driving routes.

The setting could not be more scenic for a [farm tour and sheepdog demo](#) at Tom Nee's farm above Killary Harbour. Don't worry if we don't get time today; you will enjoy a sheep farm tour on Day 7 instead.

Accommodation tonight and tomorrow is at the centrally-located [Station House Hotel](#) in Clifden. This wonderful Connemara town offers options for great dining and lively traditional Irish music.

The average driving time today is 3 hours 30 minutes.

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Tour Connemara & Kylemore Abbey

DAY 5 - CLIFDEN, GALWAY to ROUNDSTONE, GALWAY (and return)

What's the classic postcard image of Ireland? We think you'll find it amid the savage beauty of [Connemara](#). Today is your chance to experience this amazing region.

Start with a self-guided tour of [Kylemore Abbey](#) – one of Ireland's most romantic historic buildings. Wander the wonderful walled garden and admire the enchanting neo-Gothic church.

The Inagh Valley is a true wilderness. Cloud shadows race across mirror lakes. Heather and wildflowers colour the stark mountains. You're headed there now.

Time permitting, we'll stop to learn about peat bogs and their role in Irish myths, history, literature and daily life.

You'll complete your lap of Connemara by dropping into the picturesque harbour village of Roundstone, situated on the shores of the Atlantic.

Accommodation tonight is once again at the centrally-located [Station House Hotel in Clifden](#).

The average driving time today is 2 hours.

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Guided Castle Tour & Burren National Park

DAY 6 - CLIFDEN, GALWAY to BALLYVAUGHAN, CLARE

Take a guided tour of 16th century [Aughnanure Castle](#), ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan.

We're aiming for Galway next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Spot black-hulled, red-sailed Hooker boats and picturesque [Dunguaire Castle](#) in the village of Kinvara, on Galway Bay.

Next is the bewitching beauty of [the Burren region](#), with its limestone lunar landscape, and uniquely rich flora.

Marvel at the [Poulnabrone Dolmen](#), one of Ireland's great archaeological treasures. It's older than the pyramids!

Your accommodation tonight is the [Wild Atlantic Lodge](#) in beautiful Ballyvaughan.

The average driving time today is 3 hours 30 minutes.

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Cliffs of Moher & Guided Sheep Farm Tour

DAY 7 - BALLYVAUGHAN, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Hold onto your hat! It's the world famous [Cliffs of Moher](#). These majestic 700ft high sea cliffs hold the power to dazzle all comers.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the Shannon - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Kingdom' of Kerry.

We move onward, to Tralee. The largest town in Kerry is home of the Rose of Tralee festival and a beautiful rose garden.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live sheepdog demo and a [guided farm tour](#) (if we haven't visited earlier in the tour).

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the South Pole Inn. Relive the extraordinary deeds of its one time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

[Dingle](#) awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

Enjoy traditional Irish warmth and comfort at the centrally located [Dingle Benners Hotel](#) tonight and tomorrow.

The average driving time today is 4 hours.

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Whiskey, Scenic Drive & Boat Trip in Dingle

DAY 8 - DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. Relax and soak up [Dingle's charms](#), with the option for some quality downtime.

Enjoy one or more of the following activities:

- Explore spectacular Dingle Bay on a boat trip (Tour Option - €10 per person)
- Take a tour of a working craft studio at [Dingle Crystal](#).
- Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity (Tour Option - variable cost)

Experience one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed on [Slea Head](#), Europe's westernmost point.

Look out for the [Blasket Islands](#) and the holy Mount Brandon as well as picture perfect patchwork fields and cottages.

Whatever you do in Dingle, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.

Your accommodation is once again at [Dingle Benners Hotel](#).

The average driving time today is 1 hour 30 minutes.

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Horse-Drawn Carriage Ride In National Park

DAY 9 - DINGLE, KERRY to GLENGARRIFF, CORK

Start the day with a scenic drive along the coast of the Dingle Peninsula, with a photo stop and perhaps a stroll along the beach at Inch Strand.

Pay a visit to the stunning [Killarney National Park](#). Take a horse-drawn carriage ride around this magnificent parkland (Tour Option - €15 per person).

Your experience in Killarney National Park may include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House and Gardens
- A short walk to scenic Torc Waterfall
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around [ancient stone circles](#). Astrology? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

We'll hit Glengarriff in the early evening. The charming and historic [Eccles Hotel](#) on the shores of Bantry Bay is your accommodation for the night.

The average driving time today is 2 hours 30 minutes.

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Historic Tour & Island Boat Trip In Cork

DAY 10 - GLENGARRIFF, CORK to GOUGANE BARRA or SKIBBEREEN, CORK

Expect rugged roads, superb scenery and livestock-induced traffic jams as we explore further on the remote [Beara Peninsula](#).

Board a boat for the short and scenic trip to [Garnish Island](#). Explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Tour Option - €18 per person). On your boat ride, look out for cheeky seals around the harbour area of Glengarriff.

Cross the Caha Mountains with a scenic drive across the [Healy Pass](#), Ireland's bendiest road.

Visit stately Bantry House, one of the few grand Irish homes still in private hands; owned by the same family since the 18th century.

There's one more drive today, a coastal ride that snakes along Bantry Bay before cutting inland.

Accommodation tonight is at the scenic [Gougane Barra Hotel](#) or the [West Cork Hotel](#), in Skibbereen.

The average driving time today is 3 hours.

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Kiss The Blarney Stone In Cork

DAY 11 - GOUGANE BARRA or SKIBBEREEN, CORK to GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye – or *slán* in Irish – there’s still time to take in some of Ireland’s highlights.

We’ll trace the valley of the River Lee, passing stone bridges and postcard-pretty countryside.

Then it’s time to kiss the famous Blarney Stone. Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of [Blarney Castle](#).

Take a self-guided tour of the [Rock of Cashel](#). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It’s an epic way to conclude our Irish odyssey.

You’ll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in Dublin between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new travel buddies!
