GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to GARRYVOE,

Overnight Stay THE GARRYVOE HOTEL

KILKENNY & MIDLETON DISTILLERY

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the **Grand Canal Hotel**, **Dublin**, at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.00am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Our first stop is historic **Kilkenny**. The elegant Marble City was Ireland's medieval capital. Take a self-guided tour of **Kilkenny Castle** (Optional Extra), or spend your time exploring the cobbled streets.

Take a scenic drive through county **Waterford** with stunning views of the **Comeragh Mountains** before stopping off for lunch. Be sure to try a Blaa, Waterford's famously soft, white and floury bread roll.

Follow the coast to the **Jameson Distillery** in Midleton (Fee Included). Enjoy a guided tour at the home of Irish whiskey — including an all-important whiskey tasting!

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we traverse the remote **Beara Peninsula**. Take a spin over the **Caha Pass** one of the most dramatic and scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

Learn about **Irish crafts and culture** during a fun stop at a traditional farmhouse in County Kerry.

- **B.** Alternatively, enjoy free time to explore the National Park on foot. Your visit may include sightings of rare red deer, oak forests or an ancient yew tree growing at the heart of ruined **Muckross Abbey**.

Next, we will experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

In the afternoon, soak up the charms of **Dingle**. Stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries, boutique shops and craft studios.

On your way to Clare, cross the **River Shannon**, Ireland's longest river. Keep an eye out for low-flying dolphins (Fee Included).

See dry stone walls, shipwrecks and other amazing island sights. Enjoy unique views of the Cliffs Of Moher on a return boat cruise.

B. Embark on a scenic drive through spectacular north Clare, where the limestone landscape meets the Atlantic Ocean in the mind-blowing Burren National Park.

Finish the day at the majestic 700ft high Cliffs of Moher (Fee Included).
