Day 1



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to KILKENNY

Overnight Stay

KILKENNY & WICKLOW MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin**, at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.10am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Our very first stop is **Glendalough**. This 6th century monastic city is located in a steep mountain valley between two lakes and native oak forest.

You'll feel much further than 60 minutes from Dublin in the **Wicklow Mountains National Park**, part of Ireland's largest upland wilderness.

Next, drop into the hillside village of **Hollywood**. Enjoy a **sheepdog demo**, led and explained by a local farmer.

Travel back to the Bronze Age at **Rathgall**, one of Ireland's largest and most ancient ringforts.

The historic city of Kilkenny awaits this evening.

Day 2

KILKENNY CITY & CASTLE

This morning, Explore the medieval city of **Kilkenny**, with its craft studios, cafés and cobbled streets.

History buffs will enjoy a guided tour of **Kilkenny Castle** (Tour Option). Watch out for the ghost of Strongbow!

Do you believe in Santa Claus? See the purported grave of Saint Nicholas on a guided tour of medieval Jerpoint Park (Fee Inclued).

Board a replica 1840s emigrant vessel in **New Ross** — the **Dunbrody Famine Ship** — for a guided tour (Fee Included).

If time allows, orient yourself with Waterford city's Viking Triangle on a guided walking tour (Tour Option). This tour is part of a Viking Triangle Freedom Pass.

WATERFORD to HOOK PENINSULA, WEXFORD (and return)

LIGHTHOUSE TOUR & WATERFORD CITY

The morning, share in the story of a Norman dynasty at 13th century **Tintern Abbey** (Fee Included). Tour includes steep steps.

Don't miss a guided tour of the world's oldest operational lighthouse at **Hook Hood** (Tour Option). A beacon was first lit here 850 years ago. Tour includes steep steps.

This afternoon is yours to design in Waterford city.

TOUR OPTIONS (Choose A, B or C)

- A. The Viking Triangle Freedom Pass includes access to the Medieval Museum, the Bishop's Palace Museum, the Irish Silver Museum and the Museum of Time (Tour Option).
- **B.** Watch Norsemen come to life at the **King of the Vikings VR Experience** (Tour Option).
- **C.** Tour the **House of Waterford Crystal**, the world's largest Waterford Crystal collection (Tour Option).

Day 4

Average Driving 3 Hours **COPPER COAST & WHISKEY TOUR**

Today we'll discover secret coves and geological wonders on the **Copper Coast**. This coastline is one of Ireland's least known but most rewarding routes.

Detour through the **Comeragh Mountains** followed by an easy hike to **Mahon Falls**.

Lunch in the picturesque coastal town of **Dungarvan**.

Whether you're a connoisseur or just whiskey-curious, you'll be revivified by the guided tour of **Jameson Whiskey in Midleton** (Fee Included).

The **Kindred Spirits** sculpture commemorates Native American aid for victims of the Irish Famine.

Arrive this evening in **Ballycotton**, a quaint coastal village in Cork.

Cobh is our first port of call today; this historic maritime town played host to the Titanic back in 1912.

While visiting Cobh, you have the freedom to visit the Queenstown Experience to learn about Irish emigration (Tour Option).

Seafood fans rejoice! The gorgeous harbour town of **Kinsale** is the unofficial **gourmet capital of Ireland**.

Enjoy free time in Kinsale this afternoon browsing abundant restaurants, pubs and craft shops. Or take a scenic coastal drive to the Old Head of Kinsale.

This evening, opt for an early check-in at your hotel. Or take a guided tour of the star-shaped **Charles Fort** at the mouth of Kinsale Harbour (Tour Option).

BLARNEY STONE & ROCK OF CASHEL

Before we say goodbye — *slán* in Irish — there's still time for you to catch some of southern Ireland's most amazing sights.

After breakfast, it's time to kiss the world famous **Blarney Stone** and explore the lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle** (Tour Option).

Take a self-guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel** (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here too. What an epic place to conclude your southern Irish odyssey!

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new friends.
