

GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin**, at least 15 minutes before the scheduled departure time of 8.10am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

We'll stop at monumental Cahir Castle (Fee Included) for a guided tour. Gaze in awe at the imposing walls, keep and tower of one of Ireland's largest medieval fortresses. It's a fitting way to begin our Irish castle odyssey.

Then it's time to kiss the Blarney Stone (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle.**

We'll trace the valley of the River Lee, crossing stone bridges and passing through picturesque countryside.

GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to KENMARE, KERRY

Visit Carriganass Castle where you'll hear the story of Donal Cam O'Sullivan who was the last Gaelic chieftain standing in the early 1600s.

Visit stately **Bantry House**, a grand Irish home built in the 18th century (Fee Included).

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote Beara Peninsula.

Look out for seals on a scenic boat trip to **Garnish Island**. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extra).

Spin over either the **Caha** or **Healy Pass**, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone** circles. Astrology? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

Look right for views of the **Slieve Mish mountains**. Look left for a vista of scenic **Tralee Bay**.

Keep an eye out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in **Clare** (Fee Included).

Scenic drive along the west **Clare coastline** with ocean vistas of the Aran Islands, lying just offshore.

LAHINCH, CLARE to CLIFDEN, GALWAY

Next is the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and unique flora.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque **Dunguaire Castle** in the village of Kinvara, on **Galway Bay**.

We'll have a quick stop in **Galway** next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Take a guided tour of 16th century **Aughnanure Castle**, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

Revel in the savage beauty of **Connemara**, famed for its traditional Irish culture, misty mountains, wild moorlands and dark lakes.

CLIFDEN, GALWAY to BALLINA, MAYO or BOYLE, ROSCOMMON

Take a deep breath... Next is the **Doolough Valley**, one of Ireland's most scenic driving routes.

Lose a sin with every step on the holy mountain of **Croagh Patrick**. Nearby lies the ruined 16th century Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine Memorial.

Pit stop in Westport, a charismatic small town near Clew Bay.

Discover Ireland's rural heritage at the **Museum of Country Life**. This modern exhibition space also features attractive landscaped gardens.

Arise and go now, your ninth day exploring Ireland awaits...

Be sure to recite a few verses from WB Yeats, as you admire the spectacular county the Nobel Prize-winner called home; **Sligo**.

Watch shepherd and dog working in tandem during a **sheepdog demo** (Fee Included).

Stop by **Donegal town**, the home of Donegal tweed and various tempting craft shops.

Panoramic 360° vistas await you at the beautifully preserved **Celtic stone ringfort** at **Grianán of Aileach**.

Cross the border into **Northern Ireland** (remember, UK £ sterling required). We'll pass through historic city gates to enter **Derry/Londonderry**.

DERRY/LONDONDERRY to BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM

Start the day with a guided historical walking tour along the walls of Ireland's only fortified city, **Derry/Londonderry** (Fee Included).

Cameras at the ready! You're about to experience one of the most spectacular coastal drives; Northern Ireland's <u>Causeway Coastal</u> Route.

40,000 hexagonal basalt columns make up the **Giant's Causeway** (Fee Included). Choose to walk in the footsteps of mythical giant Finn McCool on a steep 1.6km (1 mile) descent/ascent. Or simply follow the accessible path to a viewing point. Shuttle bus available (Optional Extra).

Take a quick photo at clifftop **Dunluce Castle** and look out for Game of Thrones character Theon Greyjoy.

BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — slán in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Northern Ireland's highlights.

First, we'll roll into **Belfast**, the vibrant capital city of Northern Ireland.

Optional Extras (Choose A, B or C):

- **A.** A highly recommended **Black Cab Tour**, explaining the history of the Troubles era.
- **B.** Or a self-guided visit to the **Titanic Centre**.
- C. Alternatively, explore Belfast at your own pace.

Are you king or queen of the castle? Take a guided tour of **Hillsborough Castle & Gardens** to find out (Fee Included). On some dates, the British Royal Family will be in residence and your tour will visit an alternative attraction.

Cross the border back into the **Republic of Ireland** and the euro currency zone (\in).

Disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new friends.
