

Tour Map 19 Day Driftwood Discover Ireland Tour





Belfast Tour & Castle Hotel Stay



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin**, at 8.30am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Cross the border into <u>Northern Ireland</u> (remember, UK £ sterling required).

Are you king or queen of the castle? Take a guided tour of **Hillsborough Castle & Gardens** to find out (Fee Included). On some dates, the British Royal Family will be in residence and your tour will visit an alternative attraction.

We'll roll into Belfast, the vibrant capital of Northern Ireland.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C):

- **A.** Take a highly recommended **Black Cab Tour**, explaining the history of the Troubles era.
- **B.** Or a self-guided visit to the **Titanic Centre**.
- C. Alternatively, explore Belfast at your own pace.

BALLYGALLY, ANTRIM to DERRY/LONDONDERRY

Cameras at the ready! You're about to experience one of the most spectacular coastal drives; Northern Ireland's Causeway Coastal Route.

40,000 hexagonal basalt columns make up the Giant's Causeway (Fee Included), a World Heritage Site.

Choose to walk in the footsteps of mythical giant Finn McCool on a steep 1km (1.6 mile) descent/ascent. Or simply follow an accessible path to the Giant's Causeway viewing point. Shuttle bus available (Optional Extra).

Anyone for a wee dram? Visit **Bushmills**, the oldest licensed whiskey distillery in the world, for a tasting (Optional Extra).

We'll stop at clifftop **Dunluce Castle** (Fee Included) before passing through historic gates to enter the city of **Derry/Londonderry**.







Mount Falcon Estate & Spa is always a guest favourite on our tours visiting Mayo and the northwest.

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OCEAN SANDS HOTEL



Expect a warm Irish welcome at the beachside Ocean Sands Hotel in Sligo.

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DERRY/LONDONDERRY to BALLINA, MAYO

Start the day with a guided historical walking tour along the walls of Ireland's only fortified city, <u>Derry/Londonderry</u> (Fee Included).

Cross the border into the **Republic of Ireland** and the euro currency zone (€).

Panoramic 360° vistas await you at the beautifully preserved **Celtic stone ringfort** at <u>Grianán of Aileach</u>.

Stop into **Donegal town**, with the option for a guided tour of 15th century <u>Donegal Castle</u>. Please note, castle tour may occur later on some departures.

Be sure to recite a few verses from WB Yeats, as you admire the spectacular county the Nobel Prize-winner called home; Sligo.

Mayo, Connemara & Sheepdog Demo



BALLINA, MAYO to CLIFDEN, GALWAY

Discover Ireland's rich rural heritage at the Museum of Country Life's modern exhibition space and Victorian landscaped gardens.

Pit stop in Westport, a charismatic small town near Clew Bay.

Lose a sin with every step on the holy mountain of **Croagh Patrick**. Nearby lies the ruined 16th century Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine Memorial.

Take a deep breath... Next is the **Doolough Valley**, one of Ireland's most scenic driving routes.

The setting could not be more scenic for a <u>sheep farm</u> **tour** and **sheepdog demo** at Tom Nee's farm above Killary Harbour (Fee Included). Don't worry if we don't get time today; you will enjoy a sheep farm tour on Day 7 instead.

Tour Connemara & Kylemore Abbey



CLIFDEN, GALWAY

What's the classic postcard image of Ireland? We think you'll find it amid the savage beauty of Connemara.

Cloud shadows race across mirror lakes. Heather and wildflowers colour the stark mountains. Today is your chance to experience this amazing region.

Start with a self-guided tour of the beautiful Kylemore Abbey (Fee Included). Wander the wonderful walled garden — bananas were grown here in the 1800s — or admire the enchanting neo-Gothic church.

Time permitting, we'll stop to learn about peat bogs and their role in Irish myths, history, literature and daily life.

Enjoy the wild landscapes, charming villages, craft shops, pubs and cottages of Connemara.

Castle Tour & The Burren



CLIFDEN, GALWAY to SPANISH POINT, CLARE

Take a guided tour of 16th century Aughnanure Castle, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may occur on Day 3.

We're aiming for <u>Galway</u> next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque **Dunguaire Castle** in the village of Kinvara, on Galway Bay.

Next is the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora.

Hold onto your hat! It's the world famous **Cliffs of Moher** (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700 ft (215m) high sea cliffs.

SPANISH POINT, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Drive along the <u>Clare</u> coastline with uninterrupted ocean vistas.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Kingdom' of Kerry (Fee Included).

Tour a working Irish <u>sheep farm</u> with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may happen on Day 4.

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive the extraordinary deeds of its one time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. This morning, soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following relaxed activities.

Optional Extras (Choose A, B or C):

- A. Take a boat trip around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **B.** Savour a guided **craft tour** of the **Dingle Crystal** studio.
- **C.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

Experience <u>Slea Head</u>, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Whatever you do in **Dingle**, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.

DINGLE, KERRY to GLENGARRIFF, CORK

Start the day with a scenic drive along the coast of the **Dingle Peninsula**, with a photo stop and a stroll along the beach at Inch
Strand.

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone circles**. Astrology? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

Take a **horse-drawn carriage ride** around **Killarney National Park** (Optional Extra).

Your visit to Killarney may also include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House & Gardens
- A short walk to scenic **Torc Waterfall**
- An ancient yew tree at the heart of ruined Muckross Abbey

MACROOM CASTLE HOTEL



Expect a warm Irish welcome at this locally-owned 4 star hotel in the village of Macroom in Cork.

GLENGARRIFF, CORK to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote Beara Peninsula.

Of the four peninsulas in Ireland's southwest, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors and has the feeling of true wilderness.

Look out for seals on a scenic **boat trip** to <u>Garnish Island</u>. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extra).

Take a spin over either the **Caha** or <u>Healy Pass</u>, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the **Beara Peninsula**.

Visit stately **Bantry House**, a grand Irish home built in the 18th century (Fee Included).

There's one more drive today, a coastal ride that snakes along Bantry Bay before cutting inland.

GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — $sl\acute{a}n$ in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

We'll trace the valley of the **River Lee**, crossing stone bridges and passing through picturesque countryside.

Then it's time to kiss the **Blarney Stone** (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of <u>Blarney Castle</u>.

En route back to Dublin, enjoy a self-guided tour of the Rock of Cashel (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It's an epic way to conclude our Irish odyssey.

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new travel buddies!
