Departing **Dublin**, you'll hike in the **Wicklow Mountains** before venturing to **Kilkenny**. Travel to **Cork**, to explore in-depth. Follow the **Wild Atlantic Way** along the **Ring Of Kerry** and up the west coast to **Clare** and **Galway** returning to Dublin via **Athlone** and **Lough Ree**.



This tour travels in a clockwise direction.





Enjoy 4 two-night stays as you explore the stunning **southwest of Ireland**, including 4 nights in **Cork**.



Challenge yourself with spectacular hikes and optional **activities** like canoeing, biking, surfing and sea kayaking.

Before long, you will be far from civilisation hiking in the Wicklow Mountains National Park. In stunning Glendalough, a 6th century monastic city, round tower and two mountain lakes lie amidst an ancient native forest.

After lunch, watch shepherd and dog working in tandem during a **sheepdog demo** at a working sheep farm (Fee Included).

Next up is the **Shackleton Experience** (Fee Included). Learn all about the extraordinary life of this legendary Irish polar explorer, before making your way to Kilkenny, Ireland's medieval capital.

Start your day discovering secret coves and geological wonders on the **Copper Coast**. It's one of Ireland's least visited but most rewarding coastal routes.

Next, hop on a bike and explore the **Waterford Greenway** (Optional Extra). Travel through time and nature on this offroad cycle trail along Ireland's southern coastline.

If you don't fancy the Greenway, the alternative activity is exploring the nearby **Comeragh Mountains**. Hike to the base of **Mahon Falls**, a scenic 80m (262ft) high waterfall.

This afternoon, we'll hike a cliff trail along the stunning coastline in **Ardmore**. The starting point is a medieval monastic site and round tower; reputed to be where Christianity began in Ireland.

Start your day — hygienically — kissing the famous **Blarney Stone** to gain the gift o' the gab (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the lush, landscaped gardens of Blarney Castle (Fee Included).

Next up, pass through the Lee Valley in central **Cork** and stretch your legs on a scenic hike with rewarding views.


After lunch, visit **Béal na Bláth** where Michael Collins was assasinated during the Irish War of Independence.

- **B.** Embark on a scenic drive through spectacular north Clare, where the limestone landscape meets the Atlantic Ocean in the mind-blowing Burren National Park.

GALWAY to GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN

Before we wave goodbye — $sl\acute{a}n$ in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

We'll first take a guided tour of dramatic three-storey **Athenry Castle** (Fee Included), built in the thirteenth century.

Next, we're **Athlone** bound. Stop for lunch and enjoy a drink at Sean's Bar, Ireland's oldest public house.

The final stop today, will be at **Kilbeggan Distillery** (Fee Included). Tour the distillery and enjoy a tasting before making the journey back to Dublin.

You'll disembark your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new travel compadres.


