Belfast Tour & Scenic Hike



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to CARNLOUGH, ANTRIM

Meet your VagaGuide and fellow Vagabonds at reception of the **Grand Canal Hotel, Dublin** on Monday at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.20am. Board your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle and hit the road!

Cross the border into **Northern Ireland** (remember, UK £ sterling required).

Climb **Slieve Gullion** mountain (573 m / 1,880 ft) to one of Ireland's highest passage tombs. Enjoy great views and mysterious folk myths.

Zoom to **Belfast**, the vibrant capital of Northern Ireland, to choose from the following activities:

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C)

- **A**. A highly recommended **Black Cab Tou**r, explaining the history of the Troubles era.
- **B**. Or a self-guided visit to the **Titanic Centre**.
- C. Alternatively, explore Belfast at your own pace.

CARNLOUGH, ANTRIM to LIMAVADY, DERRY

Cameras at the ready! You'll wake up on one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives, Antrim's Causeway Coastal Route.

First stop, is the Carrick-a-Rede rope bridge. Walk across the suspended bridge 100ft above the North Atlantic, first errected by local salmon fishermen over 250 years ago.

Next up, hike the Causeway Coast Way. The finale of this steep, often muddy trail, lies at the **Giant's Causeway**.

Experience the Giant's Causeway (Fee Included). Science tells us this World Heritage Site formed millions of years ago when magma cooled into 40,000 hexagonal basalt columns. But folklore says Finn McCool and his giant-fighting ways are to blame!

We'll end the day with a photo stop at clifftop **Dunluce Castle**.

DONEGAL TOWN to ENNISCRONE, SLIGO

After lunch, admire the skills of farmer and faithful friend at work during an exciting **sheepdog demo** (Fee Included).

Relish a restorative session of seaweed spa therapy in **Enniscrone** (Optional Extra).

Lose a sin with every step on the holy mountain of **Croagh Patrick**. Nearby lies the ruined 16th century Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine Memorial.

Take a deep breath... Next is the **Doolough Valley**, one of Ireland's most scenic routes.

Revel in the savage beauty of **Connemara**, famed for its traditional lrish culture, misty mountains, wild moorlands and dark lakes.

Hike in the **Connemara National Park** area. Boardwalk on lower slopes leads to steep, loose and uneven terrain. Duration: 2 hours 30 minutes.

Next is the bewitching beauty of **Burren National Park**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora

Hold onto your hat! It's the <u>Cliffs of Moher</u> (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700ft high sea cliffs.

SPANISH POINT, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we ferry across the **Shannon** — Ireland's broadest, longest river — to arrive in 'The Kingdom' of Kerry (Fee Included).

Climb the steep, glaciated valley of **Annascaul**. Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes. Expect rough terrain and stunning views.

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive its extraordinary landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. Soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following activities.

Experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B, C, D, E or F):

- A. Go horseback-riding up a mountain.
- **B**. Guided **rowing experience** in a traditional Naomhóg boat.
- C. Take a gentle **boat trip** around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **D**. Guided **sea kayaking** on Dingle Bay.
- **E.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

This evening, don't miss a traditional <u>Irish music session</u> in one of Dingle's many pubs.

Biking not your thing? You're free to roam this magnificent parkland. Highlights of **Killarney National Park** for both bikers and hikers may include:

- Idyllic lakes, waterfalls and mountain views
- Native flora and fauna such as red deer and oak forest

If it's a clear night, look up... Kerry is an International Dark Sky **Reserve**. The night sky here offers crystal clear views of the Milky Way.

Skellig Michael Boat Trip & Hike



PORTMAGEE, KERRY to KENMARE, KERRY

Experience Ireland's island treasures; the Skelligs.

Option 1: Boat trip and hike to the 1400 year old monastic site on **Skellig Michael** (Optional Extra). 5 hours duration. Depart early. Jump from boat to shore, then climb 600+ rough-cut, stone steps to the summit. High levels of fitness required. **Please inform us of your intention to land on Skellig Michael pre-tour, to avoid disappointment.**

Option 2: Boat trip around both Skellig Islands (Optional Extra). Expect seabirds and amazing stories. Duration: 2 hour 30 minutes.

Both boat trips cross open ocean. They are highly weather dependent and subject to cancellation. Departures run mid-May to mid-September only. Boats are small and conditions can be rough and wet; sea legs required.

Option 3: Hike to the historic signal tower on Bray Head for amazing sea views. Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes.

Catch authentic traditional Irish music and outstanding local food in quaint **Kenmare**.

MACROOM CASTLE HOTEL

Beara Peninsula Wilderness



KENMARE, KERRY to GOUGANE BARRA, CORK or MACROOM, CORK

You're about to feel true wilderness. Expect rugged roads, superb scenery and livestock-induced traffic jams on the remote Beara Peninsula.

Take a spin over the **Healy Pass**, a dramatically scenic mountain road on the Beara Peninsula, and Ireland's twistiest road.

Get out on the water to explore the nooks and crannies of the coast and spot marine life on an epic sea safari tour (Optional Extra).

Alternatively, enjoy a scenic coastal hike around Bullig Bay with views of Bere Island and visit the ruins of Dunboy Castle.

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone** circles. Astrology? Aliens? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN

Before we wave goodbye — *slán* in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

We'll first trace the valley of the **River Lee** downstream, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

Then it's time to — hygienically — kiss the famous **Blarney Stone** to gain the gift o' the gab (Fee Included). You also have the option explore the lush, landscaped gardens around **Blarney Castle**.

Take a self-guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel** (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. We think it's a fittingly epic place to draw your Irish odyssey to a close.

You'll disembark your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new travel compadres.
