GLENGARRIFF or BALLYLICKEY, CORK to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we wave goodbye, there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

First, we'll trace the valley of the River Lee downstream, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

Then it's time to kiss the famous <u>Blarney Stone</u> (Fee Included). You can also choose to explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle**.

En route to Dublin, we'll stop off at **Cahir Castle** (Fee Included). Step inside the banqueting hall and spot the cannonball left by besiegers here in 1599. What an epic way to conclude our Irish odyssey!

You'll disembark your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in Dublin between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new travel buddies.
