Head south from <u>Dublin</u> to <u>Cork</u> via Tipperary. Explore the remote Beara Peninsula followed by <u>Killarney National Park</u> and 2 nights in <u>Dingle</u>. In <u>Clare</u>, you'll see the <u>Cliffs of Moher and The Burren</u>. Finally, enjoy <u>Galway</u> and <u>Connemara</u>.

Connemara to **Clare**; **Kerry** to **West Cork**, this tour visits highlights of the southwestern **Wild Atlantic Way** touring route.



Take a guided, open ocean boat trip around the **Skellig Islands** to experience wildlife and an ethereal monastic story.



Get blown away by the beauty of three National Parks; Connemara, Killarney and the Burren.



Flexible adventure options abound, such as **horseback-riding**, sea kayaking, trail biking and even coldwater surfing.

Blarney Stone & Rock Of Cashel



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Meet your VagaGuide and fellow Vagabonds at reception of the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin** at 8.30am. Board your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle and hit the road!

Kickstart your Irish odyssey in style with a self-guided tour of the Rock of Cashel (Fee Included). You're in good company. Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here in the 5th century. In the year 978, Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland on the same spot.

We'll roll southward through Tipperary, moving into the famous green fields and hills of Cork.

Then it's time to — hygienically — kiss the famous Blarney Stone to gain the gift o' the gab (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the lush, landscaped gardens of Blarney Castle.

We'll trace the valley of the **River Lee**, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

The Beara Wilderness In West Cork



GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to KENMARE, KERRY

Vagabonds, meet the Atlantic. **Atlantic Ocean**, the Vagabonds...

You're about to feel true wilderness. Expect rugged roads, superb scenery and livestock-induced traffic jams on the remote <u>Beara Peninsula</u>.

Of the four peninsulas in Ireland's southwestern corner, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors. It's a cliché; but the Beara is truly off the beaten track.

Hike Bullig Bay for views of Bere Island and picnic opportunities at Dunboy Castle.

Take a spin over either the **Caha** or <u>Healy Pass</u>, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone circles**. Astrology? Aliens? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

Killarney National Park



KENMARE, KERRY to PORTMAGEE, KERRY

Roam the spectacular lakeside meadows and native oak woodlands of <u>Killarney National Park</u>. You visit may include:

- Sightings of rare red deer
- The stately 19th century Muckross House & Gardens
- A short but scenic hike to Torc Waterfall
- A magical, centuries-old **yew tree** growing at the centre of a ruined medieval abbey
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

If it's a clear night, look up... Kerry is an **International Dark Sky Reserve**. The night sky here offers crystal clear views of the Milky Way.

Skellig Islands Boat Tour Or Island



PORTMAGEE, KERRY to DINGLE, KERRY

Today is your chance to experience Ireland's island treasures; the **Skelligs**.

Option 1: Take a **guided boat trip** around both <u>Skellig Islands</u> to experience seabirds and amazing history (Optional Extra). This cruise lasts 2 hour 30 minutes.

This is an ocean crossing. Departures are seasonal (mid-May to mid-September). The 12 person capacity boats are small. The cabin conditions are rough and wet; sea legs are required. Your departure is weather dependent and, as such, occasionally subject to late cancellation.

Option 2: Landlubbers can still experience the Skelligs. Hike to the historic signal tower on Bray Head for amazing views of the islands (1 hour 30 minutes). The trail combines well-worn farm track and open hillside.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

Horseback Riding Or Kayaking



DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. Soak up the charms of Dingle, with quality downtime or a choice between the following activities.

Experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the Blasket Islands and the holy Mount Brandon among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Farm Tour & Hike Or Surfing



DINGLE, KERRY to SPANISH POINT, CLARE

Climb the steep, glaciated valley of **Annascaul**. Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes. Expect rough terrain and stunning views.

Refresh yourself with an ice cold drink at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive the extraordinary life of its one-time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** and **guided farm tour** (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may happen on Day 8.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Banner' of Clare (Fee Included).

Surf's up! Take a **surf lesson** (Optional Extra). Or simply absorb the serenity at one of Ireland's most gorgeous beaches.

Hold onto your hat! It's the **Cliffs of Moher** (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700ft high sea cliffs.

Next is the bewitching beauty of the <u>Burren National Park</u>. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora

We're steering for <u>Galway</u> next. The City of the Tribes nestles on the Atlantic Ocean and makes for an atmospheric urban experience.

Guided tour of 16th century <u>Aughnanure Castle</u>, home of the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Revel in the savage beauty of Connemara, its traditional culture, misty mountains and dark lakes.

Conclude your Irish odyssey in epic style with a guided e-bike tour of the wild Connemara region (Optional Extra).
