Tour Map 8 Day Vagabond Wild Irish Rover Tour



Head south from **Dublin** to **Cork** via Tipperary. Explore the remote Beara Peninsula followed by **Killarney National Park** and 2 nights in **Dingle**. In **Clare**, you'll see the **Cliffs of Moher** and **The Burren**. Finally, enjoy **Galway** and **Connemara**.

Connemara to **Clare**; **Kerry** to **West Cork**, this tour visits highlights of the southwestern **Wild Atlantic Way** touring route.



Take a guided, open ocean boat trip around the **Skellig Islands** to experience wildlife and an ethereal monastic story.



Get blown away by the beauty of three National Parks; Connemara, Killarney and the Burren.



Flexible adventure options abound, such as **horseback-riding**, sea kayaking, trail biking and even coldwater surfing.

Blarney Stone & Rock Of Cashel



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Meet your VagaGuide and fellow Vagabonds at reception of the Grand Canal Hotel, **Dublin** at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.20am. Board your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle and hit the road!

Kickstart your Irish odyssey in style with a self-guided tour of the **Rock** of Cashel (Fee Included). You're in good company. Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here in the 5th century. In the year 978, Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland on the same spot.

We'll roll southward through Tipperary, moving into the famous green fields and hills of Cork.

Then it's time to — hygienically — kiss the famous **Blarney Stone** to gain the gift o' the gab (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the lush, landscaped gardens of Blarney Castle.

We'll trace the valley of the River Lee, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

Beara Peninsula Wilderness



GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to KENMARE, KERRY

You're about to feel true wilderness. Expect rugged roads, superb scenery and livestock-induced traffic jams on the remote **Beara Peninsula**.

Get out on the water to explore the nooks and crannies of the coast and spot marine life on an epic sea safari tour (Optional Extra).

Alternatively, enjoy a scenic coastal hike around Bullig Bay with views of Bere Island and visit the ruins of Dunboy Castle.

One of our favourite pastimes is dancing around **ancient stone circles**. Astrology? Aliens? Sacrifice? No one truly knows what the circles were for. Let your imagination run wild!

Take a spin over the **Healy Pass**, a dramatically scenic mountain road on the Beara Peninsula, and Ireland's twistiest road.





THE MOORINGS HOTEL



Located harbourside in the picturesque village of Portmagee, the Moorings Guesthouse is the perfect base for exploring the Ring of Kerry.

Killarney & Skellig Cruise



KENMARE, KERRY to PORTMAGEE, KERRY

This morning, explore the stunning coastline of **Kenmare Bay** on a guided kayaking tour (Optional Extra).

Alternatively, take a guided hike around <u>Killarney National</u>
Park enjoying mountain views and looking out for native red deer.

After lunch, drop into **Derrynane**, one of Ireland's most gorgeous beaches and the ancestral home of **Daniel O'Connell**.

This afternoon is your chance to experience Ireland's island treasures; the **Skelligs**.

Option 1: Take a **guided boat trip** around both **Skellig Islands** to experience seabirds and amazing history (Optional Extra). Duration: 2 hour 30 minutes. This is an ocean crossing. Departures are seasonal (mid-May to mid-September). The 12 person capacity boats are small. The cabin conditions are rough and wet; sea legs are required. Your departure is weather dependent and, as such, occasionally subject to late cancellation.

Option 2: Landlubbers can still enjoy views of the Skelligs from the spectacular Kerry Cliffs (Optional Extra).

Island Hike & Ring Of Kerry



PORTMAGEE, KERRY to DINGLE, KERRY

Start today with a hike to the historic signal tower on **Bray Head** for amazing views of the Skellig Islands (1 hour 30 minutes). The trail combines well-worn farm track and open hillside.

Continue your journey along the **Ring of Kerry** with a stop at an ancient ringfort.

Take a quick stop at **Inch Beach** — the only place where an inch is actually 3 miles long.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. Soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following activities.

Experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Farm Tour & Hike Or Surfing



DINGLE, KERRY to SPANISH POINT, CLARE

Climb the steep, glaciated valley of **Annascaul**. Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes. Expect rough terrain and stunning views.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** and **guided farm tour** (Fee Included).

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Banner' of Clare (Fee Included).

Surf's up! Take a <u>surf lesson</u> (Optional Extra). Or simply absorb the serenity at one of Ireland's most gorgeous beaches.





Overnight Stay ABBEYGLEN CASTLE HOTEL CONNEMARA



The romantic Abbeyglen Castle Hotel is steeped in charm and located near Clifden in Connemara.

Cliffs Of Moher & The Burren



SPANISH POINT, CLARE to CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA

Hold onto your hat! It's the **Cliffs of Moher** (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700ft high sea cliffs.

Next is the bewitching beauty of the **Burren National Park**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora

We're steering for <u>Galway</u> next. The City of the Tribes nestles on the Atlantic Ocean and makes for an atmospheric urban experience.

Guided tour of 16th century **Aughnanure Castle**, home of the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Revel in the savage beauty of **Connemara**, its traditional culture, misty mountains and dark lakes.

Conclude your Irish odyssey in epic style with a guided e-bike tour of the wild Connemara region (Optional Extra).

You'll be exploring quiet, back country roads around **Lough Mask** on pedal-assist electric bikes. Expect to cycle 25km in distance and for up to 2.5 hours in duration. The terrain is mostly flat. Some cycling experience is required.

The e-bike tour is completely optional. For those who prefer two feet to two wheels, you can explore scenic woodlands near Lough Mask on a local hike.

Disembark your VagaTron 4x4 tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell hugs all round for your new friends.
